1 Introduction

Zug is Automature's software test automation tool. Zug provides an execution environment for tests specified using CHUR. Zug can be run on any environment that supports the Java Runtime Environment.

1.1 Document Purpose

The installation guide walks you step-by-step through installation of Zug. It gives troubleshooting information for installers. Once you install the tool, you can execute automated tests written in the spreadsheet based Chur automation language. To get further information refer [ZUG Forum](#) and can be found in the installation directory as ZUG Release Notes.txt

1.2 Intended Audience

This is intended for people who would be running test-cases written in Chur on Zug execution environment. Zug results can be further integrated with Zermatt.

Before running ZUG on a computer, it has to meet some basic requirements:

Operating System – Microsoft Windows XP or higher

Software – Microsoft Windows Installer 3.1(required only for Windows XP)

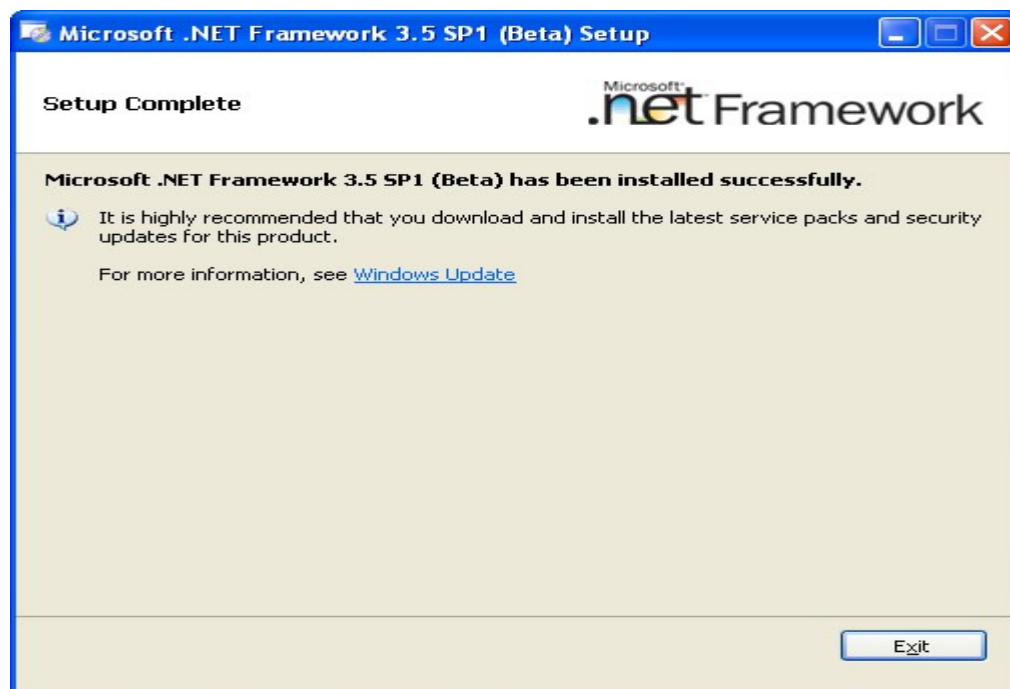
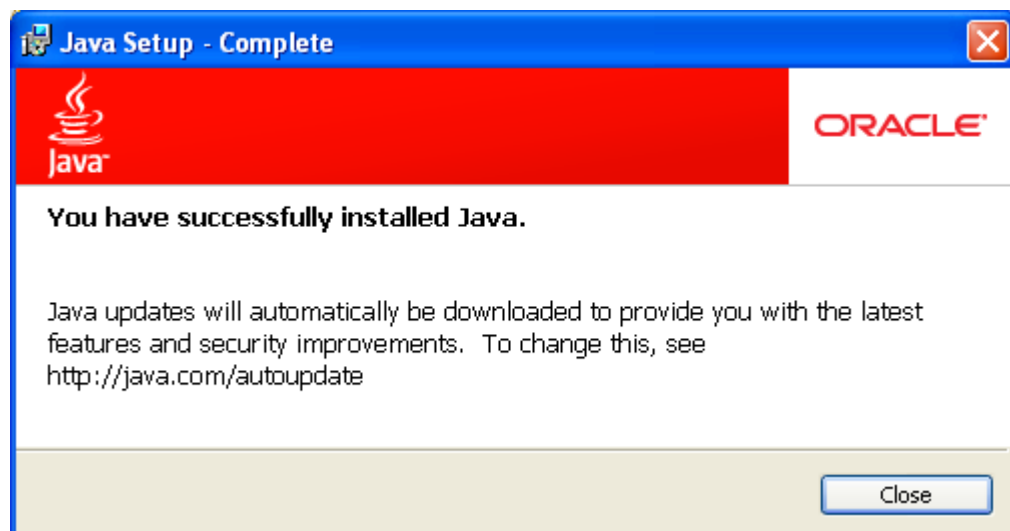

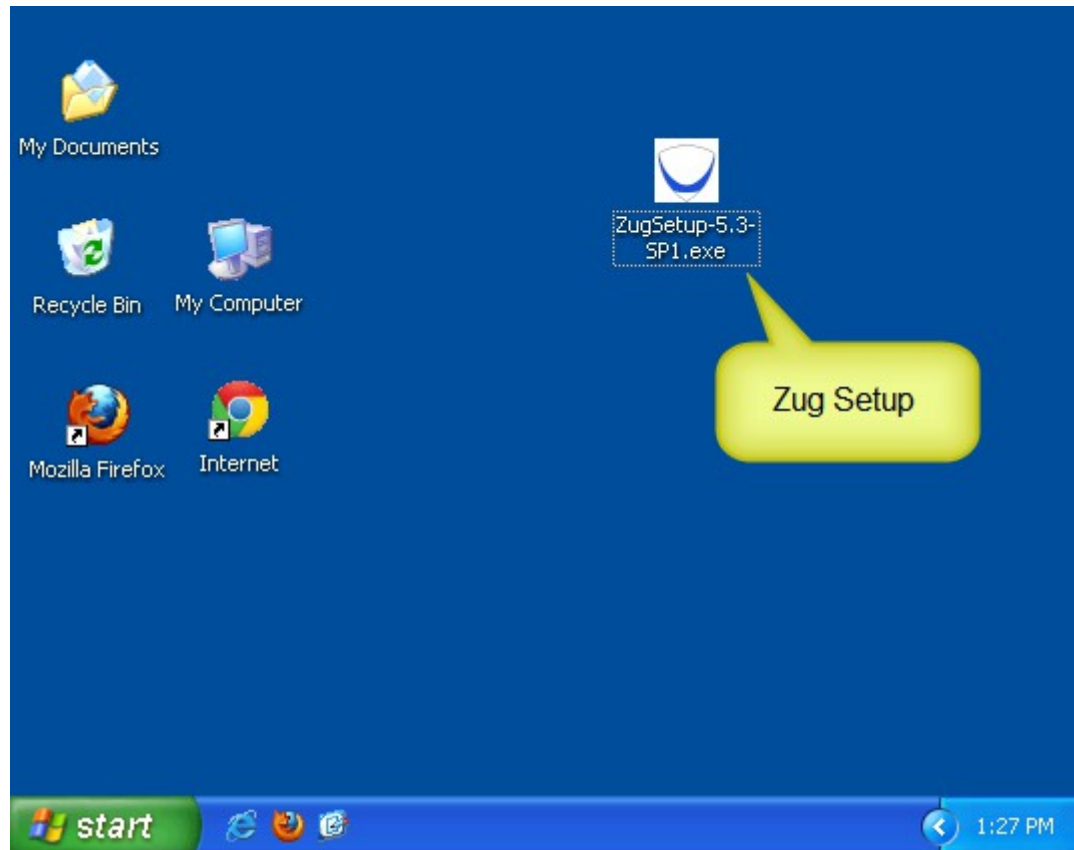

3.1 Zug installer download

Download the Setup of the latest ZUG package from the Automature FTP site. Please fill up contact information form if needed.



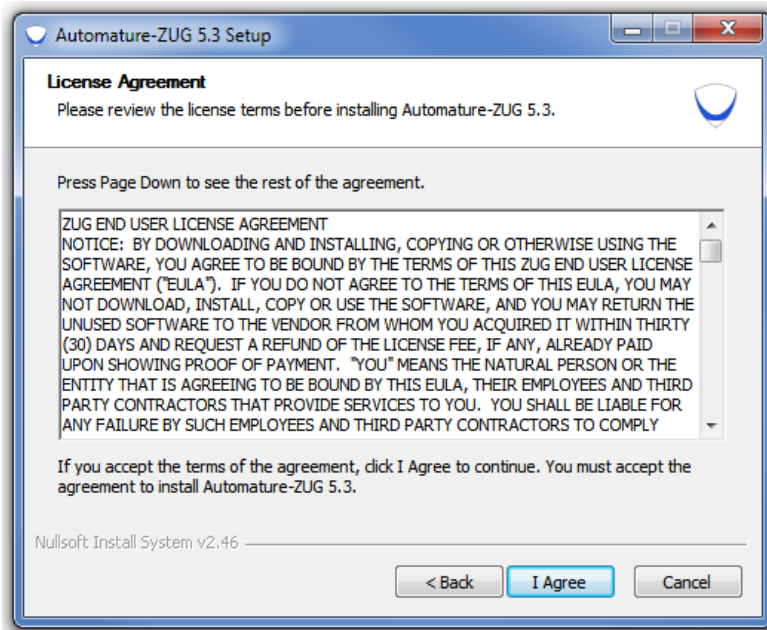

Double Click on the Zug installer icon. The set up starts automatically. The following screen appears.

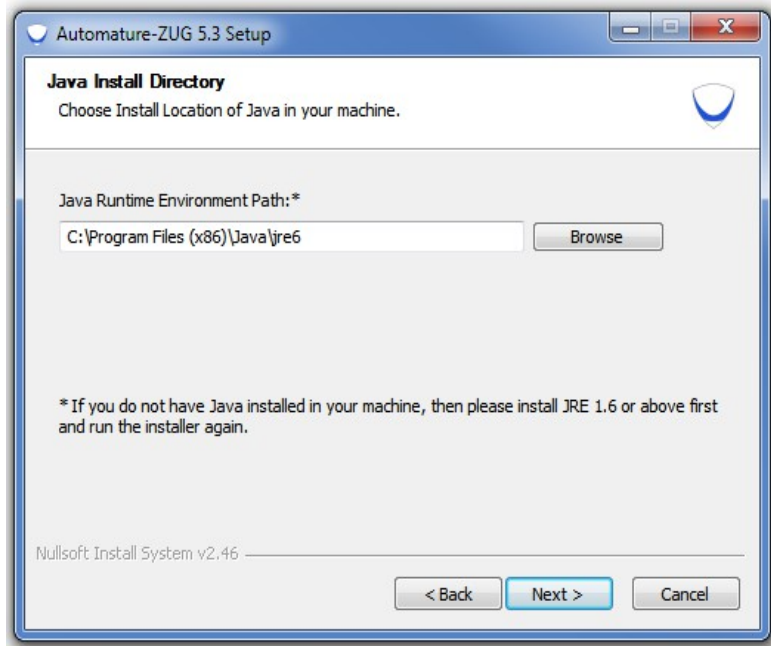


Click on Next. You will be able to view the EULA. If you agree to it, click on I Agree button. If you have any queries regarding EULA, kindly email us at sales@automature.com.

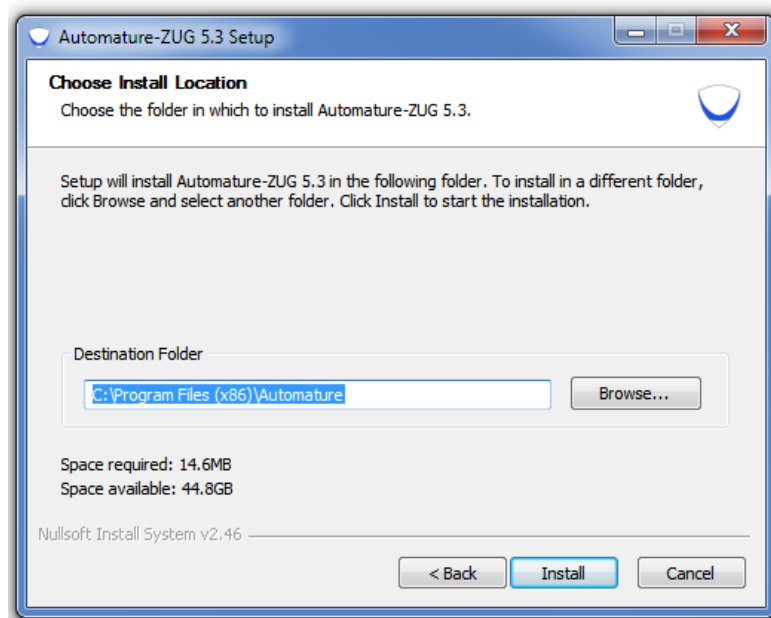

Choose the Destination path for installation of Zug.

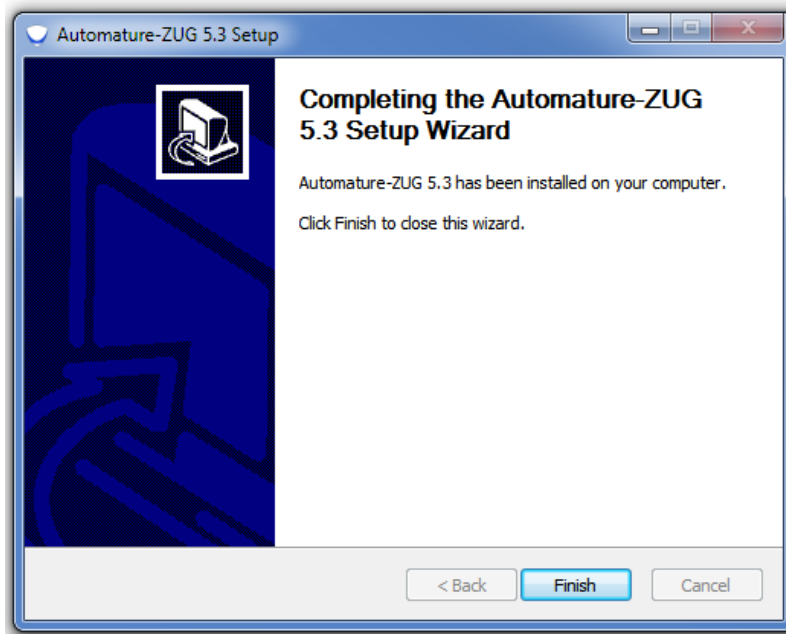

3.3 Completion of Installation

The following screen will appear once the installation is complete. This means that Zug can be run from anywhere in the command prompt window, one does not need to be in the Zug directory.



Kindly email the file Config.txt (which is created automatically in your Zug folder) to sales@automature.com to receive the copy of license for Zug (not for trial version).


3.4 Version Verification

Open a new command prompt window and type: `runZUG.bat -version` or `runzug -v`.

This is to verify that the correct version of ZUG has been installed. The version number displayed should match the version number of the package that you downloaded but it will show only if the Licence key is there in the installation directory.

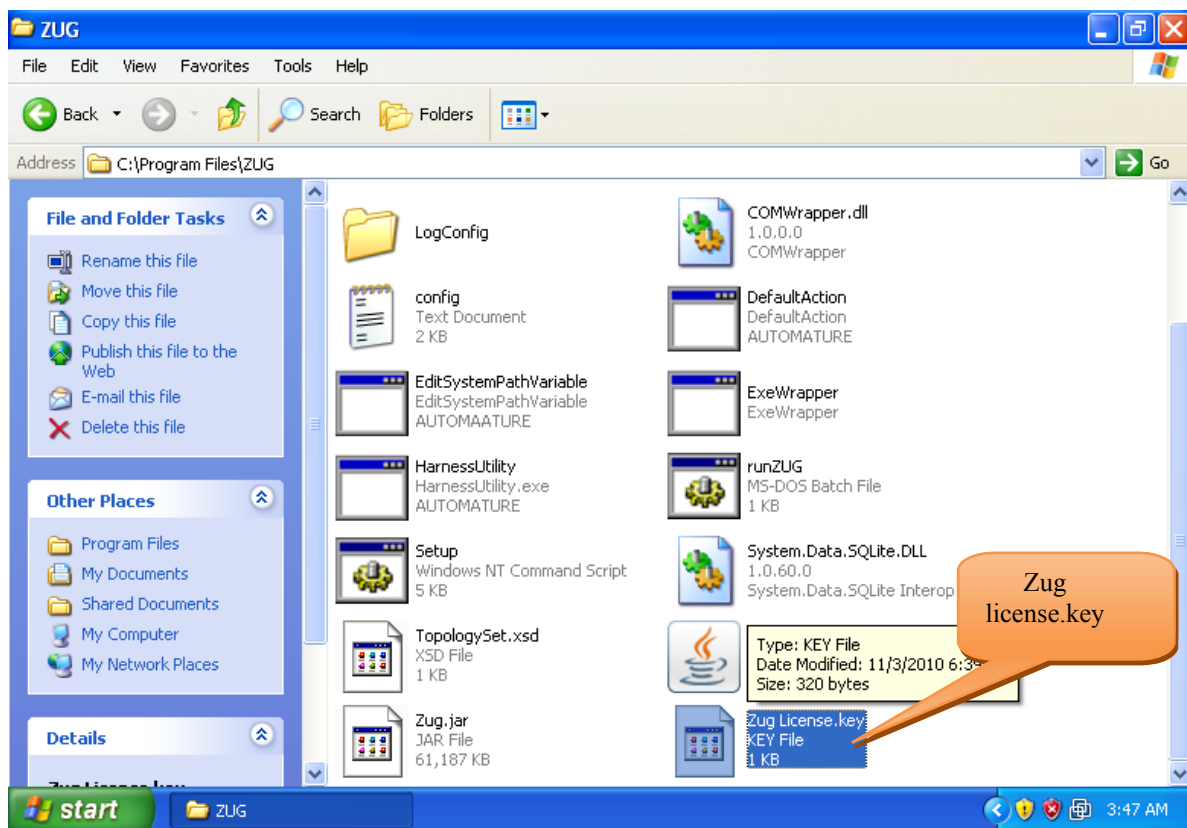

4. License Activation

Once you have successfully installed Zug in your machine, you will have to activate your License in order to use Zug.

Steps to activate your license:

- 35
17 Download the file **Zug license.key**, which is provided to you in the email address which you had given in your contact information.

17 Place the file in the Zug folder where you installed.



After Putting the file in the directory it can be checked that what is its version.

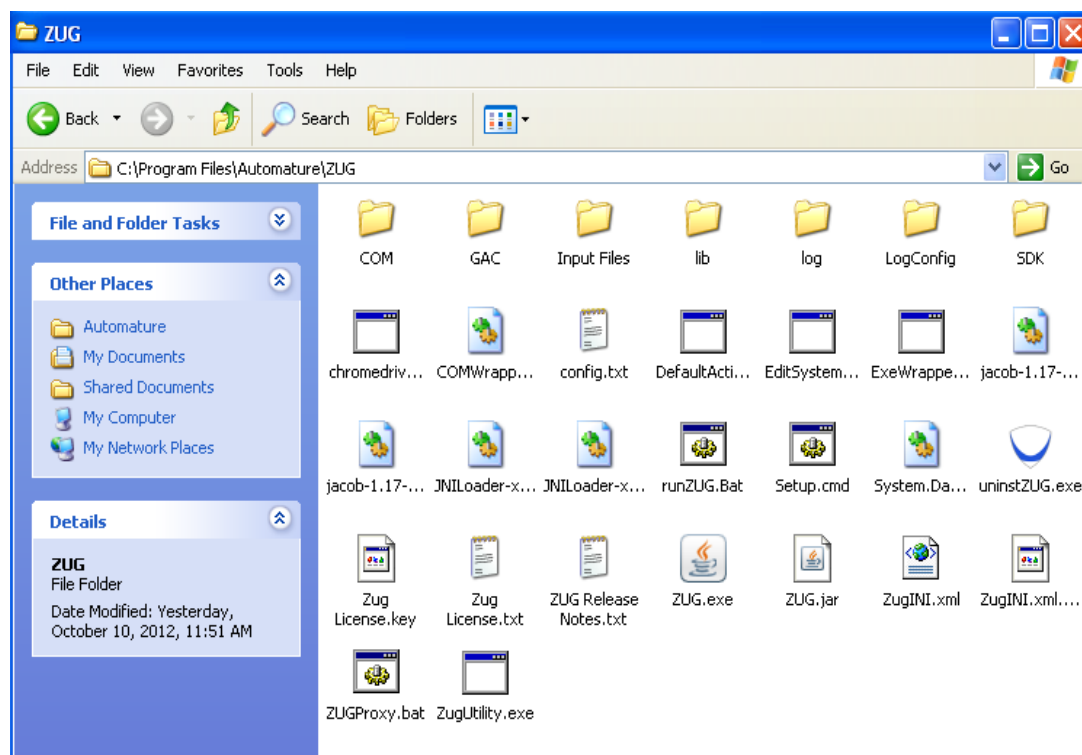

Click on the un-installation icon **uninstZug.exe** that is present in the Zug installed directory. Zug will be uninstalled automatically.

You can also un-install Zug from Control Panel as well.

Troubleshooting the Installation

If you see the following errors do the following:

³⁵₁₇ **The prompt appears when running ZugSetup.exe**

This application has failed to start because mscorere.dll was not found.
Re-installing the application may fix this problem.

Solution: This is caused when installer is not able to register ZUG API dll. The solution is to install .Net Framework v3.5

³⁵₁₇ **Error message comes up on installation saying**

Solution: This is because Microsoft .Net Framework v3.5 folder is missing. The solution is to check and re-install Microsoft Framework v3.5

³⁵₁₇ **ZugSetup.exe executed successfully, but the error message comes up when doing runZUG.bat. The error message is**

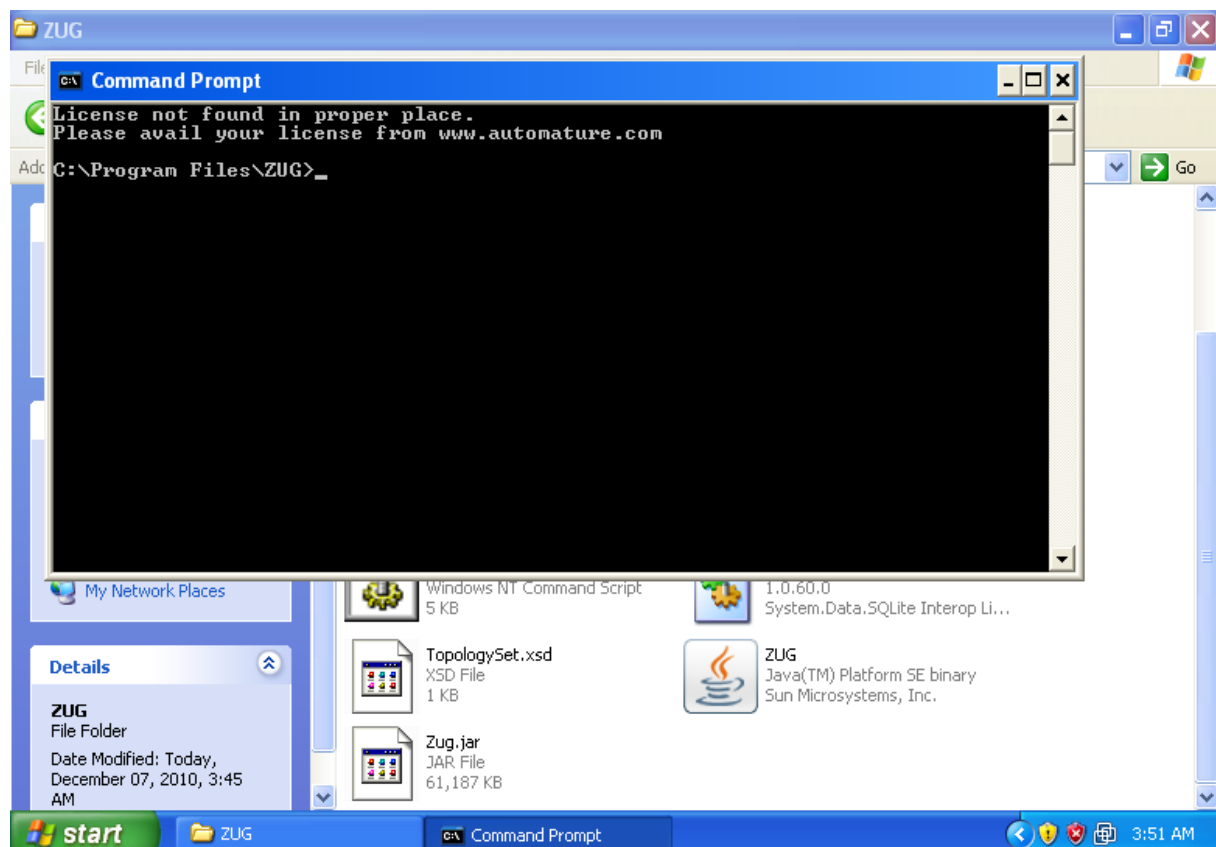
Error opening registry key 'Software\JavaSoft\Java Runtime Environment'

Error: could not find java.dll

Error: could not find java SE Runtime Environment

Solution: This is because JRE is missing in system registry. The solution to this is installing required JRE again.

³⁵₁₇ **License key not found in proper place**

Solution: The license key given to you by email needs to be placed in the folder where Zug is installed. Kindly have a look at the License Activation topic.

- **ZugINI.xml configuration**

Zug3.0 version now can call the external java jar files as builtin atoms through chur spreadsheet. To make it happen the ZugINI.xml parsing is need. Inside the Zug installation directory the ZugINI.xml file can be edited to by putting the values in the tags of

if no value is written then it will show a warning message while running the ZUG automation.

If ZUOZ is installed after ZUG installation then this part will be configured by ZUOZ installer.

- **JRE Dependency**

If the JRE is updated from java 1.6 to java 1.7 after installing ZUG then ZUG will stop working and it will give an error message similar to the message given below
